Hello everyone, here we are at the beginning of a new financial year and as I have calculated the budget for the year I thought it may be of interest to you to see where your money is being spent. I think it may be quite an eye opener to most people and hopefully you will realise how critical it is to keep the membership up and to attend the groups. The overhead annual costs of £42845 does not include payments made to Tim for the day to day maintenance of the building (this amounted to over £5000 last year) nor does it include costs of major repair work or replacement of equipment.

The income raised each week from the groups prior to Covid was averaging in excess of £1000 per week; since reopening last July it has been averaging around £600 - £700, quite a difference.

Following on from this would all group treasurers please check the membership cards to make sure that all of your members have re-joined and also a reminder to collect the annual subscription for your group from your members and sign the back of their cards to say they have paid. Random checks of membership cards may be carried out by the management committee.

We are always in need of volunteers to help run the Association so we are appealing that if you can help in any way please contact any of the management committee. Our major need at the moment is for someone to set out the tables and chairs for Friday Live; this

needs to be done prior to members arriving at 9.00am.

Following last month's introductory guide, this month we will look more closely at the Membership page (as it is that time of year again).

The membership tab is the last tab across the top of the Home Page; after clicking on this tab, the Membership will open out which will allow both application for prospective **new members**, and renewal of membership for **existing members**.

In addition, local community associations can apply to become **Affiliate Members**, and previous Affiliates can renew their membership.

When either applying for membership, or renewing membership through the web page, there is an ability to **pay** directly **using BACS**, although **cash or cheques** are still accepted but applicants will need to present themselves to reception to do so. If paying by BACS, after submission of the application you will be presented with all the appropriate bank details. If paying by cheque, please ensure that it is made payable to **Highcliffe Community Association** (not HCA).

The membership page is designed to allow members to print off the relevant forms which then need to be filled in by hand and brought to reception when payment can be made (if not already done by BACS).

Finally, a reminder that if members are tax-payers then HCA can benefit from the ability to Gift Aid – it will cost you nothing to do so, and Greystones will benefit by the sum of £2.50 per membership fee of £10. A declaration of your willingness to do so is catered for whether you apply “on-line” or via the paper application.
