Car Parking (the definitive answer)

Having now been able to review a colour master copy of our lease I am able to provide the definitive answer to the parking question.

i) The 3 spaces outside the kitchen and coffee lounge and the 2 spaces by the disabled door access are solely for the use of HCA members as they are within the boundary of the building.

Note: The Trustees have decided the spaces by the kitchen should be for HCA members who are on volunteer duty and specifically for kitchen and reception volunteers should they need to park their cars.

ii) The spaces at the front of the building (the car park) are all shared between residents and HCA attendees on a first come first served basis.

Note: Please ensure you notify reception if you are blocking anybody in a space and ensure you do not inadvertently block turning access into any spaces.





How to make the most of our website – Part 3.

This month we will look more closely at the **Events page**.

Clicking on the Events tab reveals a diary for the current (and successive) months. The initial display shows forthcoming events for the remainder of the month, with prior events automatically being excluded from view.

The page has four interactive areas

1. Above the designated month is the “**Search**” **bar**; entering all or part of a word will display only those entries with the key word; eg Entering “Amb” will display both Amble and Ramble, whilst entering “Ram” will only display Ramble
2. To the right hand side of the month are **two yellow arrows**; the right arrow will display the next month, and logically the left arrow should display the prior month, but as all events which have occurred will not be shown, there is little point in looking for them!
3. Immediately below the date is a “**Filter events**” function which changes the display from a Date display to Alphabetical display, and vice versa.
4. Finally, clicking on any **specific entry** will display more detailed information about the event (start times, directions to a ramble etc)

Usually only events which change from month to month are shown, but if any section has a “special event” (celebratory meal, outing etc) which needs publicising, please let the webmaster know using the following email address:-
