

Joseph and his Amazing Technicolour Carpet

As you will be aware we closed for the first two weeks of the year so we could get the corridors and Reception carpets re-laid. FREDA'S COOKERY CORNER

There are many singletons amongst us and also many who would rather not cook. This month's recipe is very simple and probably would be enough for two meals. To save starting from fresh each day it is a good idea to double up a recipe and freeze some away for later. None of my recipes will have unusual ingredients that you will have to go hunting for.

TUNA PASTA FOR ONE (POSSIBLY 2)

2 teasp. oil
1 medium onion chopped
1 tin (400g) chopped tomatoes
1 chopped clove of garlic (optional)
1 tbsp. tomato ketchup
75g pasta of your choice
1 small tin of tuna
grated or thinly sliced cheddar
salt & pepper



In a medium sized saucepan heat the oil and then add the chopped onion to cook on low heat with a lid on.

When the onion is soft add the tomatoes, ketchup, garlic and a little salt and pepper. Cook on low heat.

Meanwhile cook the pasta, following packet instructions. Take the sauce off the heat after 10 minutes. Drain the pasta when cooked and with the drained tin of tuna, add to the tomato sauce. Return to the heat to warm through.

Spoon your portion out onto a plate, sprinkle with grated or very thinly sliced cheese and place in the microwave for one minute to melt the cheese. Alternatively tip into an ovenproof dish and brown under the grill.
